



**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY CDC MEETING HELD WITH THE DEPARTMENTS
UNDER NCHAC, HAFLONG, DIMA HASAO**

DATE – 22nd & 23rd Aug' 2023 : TIME – 1:00 PM

VENUE : Officers' Conference Hall, NCHAC, Haflong

The meeting was chaired by Sri T.T. Daulagupu, ACS, Principal Secretary, NCHAC. He initiated the discussion by informing the House that as per instruction of the Hon'ble CEM in the meeting held with all MACs on 21/08/2023 all ongoing works / schemes are to be completed by January' 2024 without fail. As such, he requested the Departments to gear up their works more sincerely. He also pointed out that some departments were in the habit of furnishing a NIL report whenever called for by the Council which indicates that the department was lying idle till then ; although actual physical work had not commenced against the sanctioned / approved scheme but at least some paper works might have surely begun and as such departments should avoid furnishing a NIL report. Departments' report should not only focus on SOPD schemes but rather it should reflect all govt. schemes / activities / programmes etc.

Thereafter, a department-wise brief review of the departmental activities was conducted as follows :-
