

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY C.D.C. MEETING HELD WITH THE DEPARTMENTS  
UNDER NCHAC, HAFLONG, DIMA HASAO**



**DATE – 21<sup>st</sup> November' 2022 :**

**TIME – 11:00 AM**

**VENUE : CEM's Conference Hall, NCHAC, Haflong**

The meeting was presided over by the Principal Secretary, NCHAC who requested the Joint Director of Health Services, Haflong to present a deep insight on AES/JE, Dengue & other VBDs in front with data of the district. The DMO i/c presented the case scenario of AES/JE, Dengue & Malaria from 2020 to November 2022 and also explained the ongoing NCVBDC activities to control the Dengue outbreak.


In the meeting the following resolutions were adopted.

1. To control & prevent the Dengue outbreak in the district all department need to work together in a serious note.
2. Education Department will spread the awareness of Dengue/JE/AES/Malaria and ensure vaccination of students during assembly time.
3. Veterinary Department was advised to check the quality of market areas, planning for animal Health Camp regularly specially for Piggeries to prevent AES/JE. Veterinary Department was asked to identify the commercial Piggery and domestic rearing areas of Pig. They will also spread awareness in those areas regarding segregation of Piggeries and Netting of Pig Shed. The Department was also asked to work together with Health Department.
4. P.H.E Department will ensure safe drinking water for the control of Dengue, AES/JE, Malaria & other diseases. They will also aware the public on Dengue, AES/JE & Malaria through their staffs. They are also requested to clear the water logging due to pipeline leakages. They were asked to cover rural areas, Medical, School, Anganwadi Centre for all the facilities under them and also cover under Jal Jiban Mission.
5. Social Welfare Department was asked to participate in awareness activity of Vector Borne Diseases through AWW. They will also look after the improvement of nutritional status of children and also advised them to cooperate with the Medical Department.
6. Social Welfare, Education & Health Department should work together to get maximum output to control & prevention of Vector Borne Diseases.
7. Forest Department will ensure that the dweller of the Forest use mosquito net and personal protection measures.
8. The Fishery Department will provide and rate feasible larvicides fish species like Guppy in possible areas for controlling vector borne diseases. They will also spread the awareness of JE/AES/Malaria/ Dengue to the people.
9. Irrigation Department will carry out awareness programme in their jurisdiction and clear water logging wherever possible.
10. Municipalities need to look after water logging problems & carry out awareness programme in their jurisdiction. MB was advised to cooperate with the medical department to tackle with the Dengue outbreak in municipalities or town committee areas in the district.
11. District immunization officer to ensure routine immunization and also to aware the villagers on vector borne diseases during immunization.
12. SDM & HO in-charge of all BPHC will aware all the Health Workers to strengthen surveillance on JE/AES/Malaria/Dengue. They will also aware all the Medical officers at the sectoral level regarding transmission season of VBD and to suggest test.
13. The District Mission Co-ordinator, SSA, Dima Hasao, Haflong is requested to ensure that School teacher provide assistance to Health Department during the SID programme.
14. The Social Welfare Department assured full support and assistance to the Health Department and all the Anganwadi workers should be instructed to co-operate during the SID programme.
15. The DIPRO is requested to give a detailed wide publicity of the SID programme on FLS for the interest of the general public.
16. Media person will be briefed about the SID programme by the District Immunization Officer, DME, NHM Haflong Unit is requested to do the needful.

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17. Some beneficiaries are vaccinated in the private clinics which are not reported to the district, leading to increasing left out and drop outs in the HMIS portal is a matter of grave concern, DDM, NHM Haflong Unit is requested to look into the matter so that the actual data reflects in the HMIS postal.
18. All the Sector in-charge are requested to ensure that Head Count Survey report is completed on or before 12<sup>th</sup> December'2022 and submitted to the office of the Addl. C.M. & H.O. (F.W), Haflong.
19. The Administrator, Holy Spirit Hospital is requested to submit monthly performance report to the office of the Addl. C.M & H.O (FW) along with a copy to the Principal Secretary, N.C. Hills Autonomous Council, Haflong.
