

MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY C.D.C. MEETING HELD WITH THE DEPARTMENTS UNDER NCHAC, HAFLONG, DIMA HASAO



DATE -18 th July' 2022 :

TIME - 11:00 AM

VENUE: CEM's Conference Hall, NCHAC, Haflong

The meeting was presided over by Sri T.T. Daulagupu, ACS, Principal Secretary who informed the House that the meeting would basically stress on the awareness of AES/JE and other vector borne diseases among the Health workers of every Health Institute and staffs of line department in the district. The DMO i/c briefed the House regarding the aims & objectives of the meeting and presented a deep insight on AES/JE, other VDS's and the problems at hand with data DVBDC, NVBDCP presented the case scenario of AES/JE, Malaria & Dengue from 2020 to June 2022 and also presented the fever surveillance (BS/RDT collection) data of Malaria for 2019 to June 2022

In the meeting the following resolutions were adopted.

- 1. The last two years due to restriction for Covid-19, AES/JE, Malaria & other diseases were low but this year cases may rise because of withdrawn of all the restriction, flood situation, import from outside the district etc. Therefore all department needs to be hands together to control & prevent the diseases.
- 2. Veterinary Department was advised to check the quality of market areas, planning for animal health camp regularly specially for piggeries to prevent AES/JE. Veterinary Department was asked to identify the commercial piggery and domestic rearing areas of pig. They will also spread awareness in those areas regarding segregation of piggeries and netting of pig sheds. The department was also asked to target the Nomjang, Dikengma village & other susceptible areas for surveillance the piggeries and collect the sample for AES/JE test and also suggested to work together with health department.
- 3. District Immunization officer to ensure routine immunization and also to aware the villagers on vector borne diseases during immunization.
- 4. SDM & HO in-charge of all BPHC will aware all the health workers to strengthen surveillance on JE/AES/Malaria/Dengue. They will also aware all the medical officers at the sector level regarding transmission season of VBD and to suggest test.
- Social Welfare Department was asked to participate in awareness activity of vector borne diseases through AWW. They will also look after the improvement of nutritional status of children to fight the VBDs and also advised them to cooperate with the medical department.
- 6. Education Department will spread the awareness of JE/AES/Malaria/Dengue and ensure vaccination to students during assembly time and also through social media available at their disposal.
- 7. Social Welfare, Education & Health department should work together to get maximum output to control & prevention of vector Born Diseases.
- 8. PHE Department will ensure safe drinking water for the control of AES/JE, Malaria & other diseases. They will also aware the public on AES/JE/Malaria through their staffs. They are also requested to clear the water logging due to pipeline leakages. They were asked to cover rural areas, medical, school, anganwadi centre for all the facilities under them and also cover under Jal Jiban Mission.
- 9. Forest Department will ensure that the dweller of the forest use Mosquito net and personal protection measures.
- 10. The Fishery Department, Dima Hasao will provide and rare feasible larvicides indigenous fish species like Guppy in possible areas for controlling vector borne diseases. They will also spread the awareness of JE/AES/Malaria/Dengue to the people.
- 11. Irrigation Department will carry out awareness programme in their jurisdiction and clear water logging wherever possible.
- 12. Municipalities need to look after water logging problems & carry out awareness programme in their jurisdiction.
- 13. It was observed that during supervision and monitoring by Health Officials, Anganwadi workers were not available at the RI session sites and VHND. Therefore, in order to improve RI performance, BPMs/ABPMs/BEEs etc are requested to co-ordinate with the CDPOs to ensure availability of ANMs, ASHAs & Anganwadi workers at the session sites.
- 14. The sector in-charge of Health Institution are requested to co-ordinate with the Education Department to ensure Td vaccine is administered to school going children aged 5, 10 and 16 years. The Principal Secretary, NCHAC is requested to issue necessary instruction to the concerned department to arrange session in schools wherever applicable with information to the Health department for vaccination etc.

15. Any threat to Health Care Workers and staff by anti-social elements cannot not be tolerated and should be reported to the authority of the N.C.Hills Autonomous Council, Haflong for further necessary action.

16. Validation of Head Count survey by the Blocks/Sector should be submitted to the Addl. C.M. & H.O. (FW) /

DIO in the prescribed format after proper verification at the earliest.

17. During review of Routine Immunization performance, it was seen that only 18% FII was achieved in the 1st Quarter. The Sector in-charge of Health Institutions are requested to gear up activities so that 50% is achieved during 2nd Quarter.

18. As instructed by Jt. DHS (MCH) Assam during his recent visit to Dima Hasao district, special Routine Immunization drive for uncovered areas in Dima Hasao district will start w.e.f 10/08/2022 to 17/08/2022. All Sector in-charge are requested to ensure that Routine immunization is done in all the uncovered areas on

priority basis as per Micro Plan submitted by the sectors.

19. Covid-19 vaccination should continue for all categories including school along with milking in all Urban/Bazaar areas of all sectors. A wide publicity for precaution dose should be done in all urban/Bazaar areas of all sectors preferably on market days along with vaccination. The performance should be shared with the DIO for further necessary action.

20. The SDM&HO i/c Urban Health Centre is requested to arrange for Covid—19 vaccination to eligible precaution dose beneficiaries on the 11th of August'2022 near Council Rotary and on 15th of August'2022 at DHSA ground. The Council Authority and Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Vaccination, Dima Hasao is requested to

provide necessary assistance for the same.

Thereafter the meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the chair.
