

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY C.D.C. MEETING HELD WITH THE DEPARTMENTS  
UNDER NCHAC, HAFLONG, DIMA HASAO**



**DATE – 22<sup>nd</sup> April' 2024 :**

**TIME – 11:00 AM**

**VENUE : Officers' Conference Hall, NCHAC, Haflong**

The meeting was chaired by Sri T.T. Daulagupu, ACS, Principal Secretary, NCHAC. Two other Secretaries, Sri P.S. Jahari, Secretary and Sri P. Pegu, Joint Secretary assisted him in the meeting. After welcoming the members the Principal Secretary informed that the month's meeting would mainly focus towards the immense backwardness of the villages under Semkhor constituency. The area still remains the most backward in the district in terms of all indicators ; be it Health, Education, Hygiene, Malnutrition, Livelihood etc. Recently there was an outbreak of measles in which barring 2 villages the rest were affected. Then, the discussion continued as shown below :-

Sl. No	Department	Points of Discussion
1	HEALTH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Matter regarding shortage of ANM at the Sub-Centre was viewed seriously and it was decided the Jt. Director, Health should send proposal for posting adequate number of ANM, ASHAs to cover the entire sub-centre area under Semkhor constituency.</li> <li>House to house vaccination should be carried out. At this the deptt. informed that communication with the villagers was very difficult as they were not ready to listen willingly. Mobilisation was also very difficult as the villagers were sceptical about outsiders inspite of grave unhygienic condition, malnutrition ; open defecation still exists in a large manner.</li> <li>Inspite of various challenges, it was decided to conduct more awareness programmes in the area in which the Health Deptt. should take the initiative.</li> </ul>
2	BLOCK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The BDO, DVD Block, Maibang would conduct census of all the Semkhor villages and submit report which would be shared with all the other line departments to find out if all (age-wise) were covered under ICDS schemes / enrolled in schools and that whether various other benefits entitled to them were actually availed or not.</li> </ul>
3	SOCIAL WELFARE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Dy. Director, Social Welfare to ensure that all children are covered under ICDS schemes and should also move proposal for covering all the uncovered villages with Anganwadi centres.</li> <li>To take urgent necessary steps to control malnutrition.</li> </ul>
4	EDUCATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The BMC / Deputy Inspector of Schools should ensure that every child is enrolled in a school.</li> <li>To also ensure that Teachers regularly attend classes and that Mid-Day meals are provided to the students without fail.</li> <li>In view of the reported shortage of Teachers in schools, DPEO, BMC and Dy. IS are to ensure that adequate number of Teachers are posted at all times in schools in the particular area.</li> </ul>
5	P.H.E.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Addl. Chief Engineer, PHE and the Executive Engineer, PHE, Maibang to ensure completion of all JJM schemes under Semkhor constituency and ensure regular water supply.</li> <li>The Deptt. should also take up rural sanitation programme vigorously in Semkhor villages.</li> </ul>
4	A.H. & VETY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Addl. Director, A.H. &amp; Vety was asked to engage with the villagers and educate them with regard to rearing of animals especially pigs in a more scientific / healthier manner in order to avoid the outbreak of any disease.</li> </ul>

It was also decided that a convergence meeting with all concerned departments like Health, Social Welfare, Education, A.H. & Veterinary, P.H.E, Agriculture, P.W.D, Sericulture, Fishery, Handloom & Textile and DVD Block, Maibang would be scheduled at the earliest for the benefit of Semkhor area. Their meaningful upliftment requires the contribution of these departments for which their extra effort was solicited. Thereafter, the meeting concluded with vote of thanks from the Chair.
